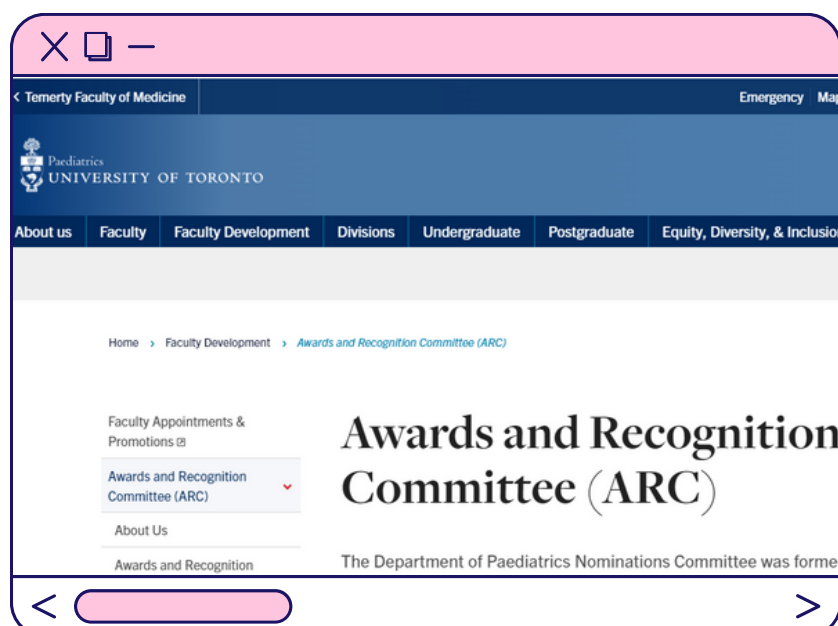
Awards Alert – Canadian Pediatric Society, due Jan 31, 2024


